

# Water cycle in a bag

**Our Earth's water cycle has been continuously recycling our water supply for more than four billion years.**

The process begins with the heat from the sun causing water to turn into steam which evaporates into the sky. Condensation then occurs when the steam cools and returns to a liquid. When the liquid becomes too heavy for the clouds to hold, precipitation occurs, with the water returning to the Earth's surface in the form of rain, hail or snow.
